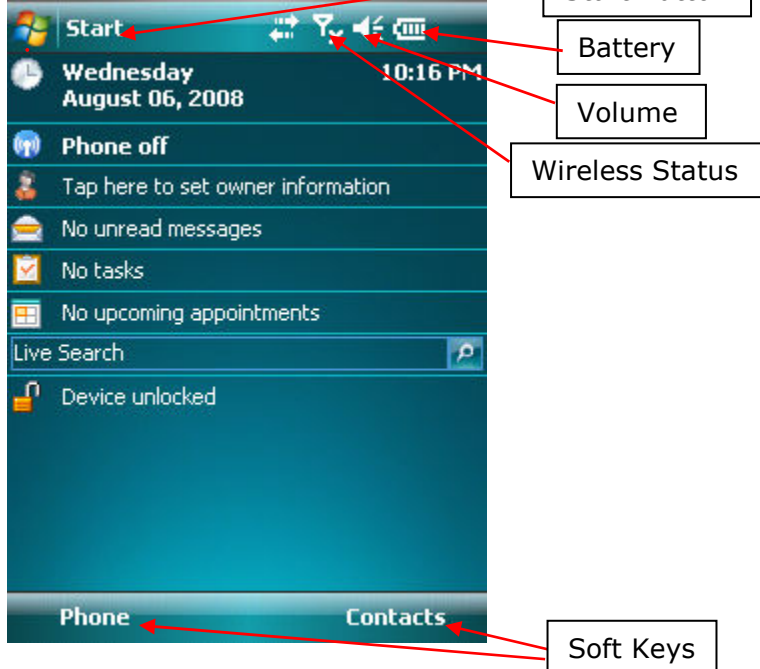
## Introducing Microsoft Windows Mobile

There are two different versions of Windows Mobile: Standard (commonly called Smartphone) and Professional (commonly called Pocket PC)

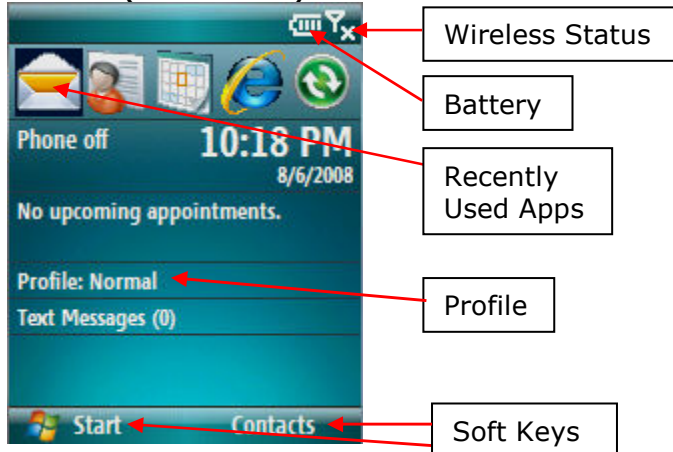
This reference is applicable to Windows Mobile 6.1, 6 and 5.0

### Standard (Home Screen):

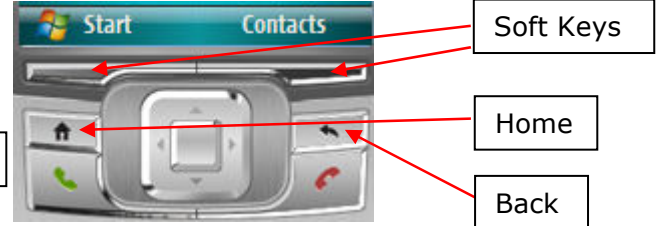


## Navigation

**Two Soft Keys** - Selections displayed above keys

**Home key** - *Standard*: Home Screen

**Back key** - *Standard*: Go Back one level

**Up / Down / Left / Right navigation** - *Directional Pad or keyboard arrows*, *Professional*: via the touch screen

**Green phone** - Dialing screen, dials the phone number

**Red Phone** - End call

**Click and hold** - *Professional*: press the stylus to the screen to display the right click menu

**OK / X** - *Professional*: Hide the window, application runs in background

## Customizing

**Home screen** - Choose what options are displayed

*Professional*: Start - Settings - Today - Items

*Standard*: Start - Settings - Home Screen

**Color Scheme** - Choose other color schemes

*Professional*: Start - Settings - Today

*Standard*: Start - Settings - Home Screen - Color Scheme

**Buttons** - Choose what applications are launched for selected buttons

*Professional*: Start - Settings - Buttons

**Profiles** - Normal, Silent, Vibrate, Outdoor, Automatic

*Standard*: Start - Settings - Profiles
